[Am] Wooh [G] [F] [Am] [C]

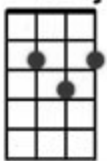
I [G] wish I was the brakeman on a [F] hurtling fevered train

[Am] Wooh [G] [F] [Am] [C] [G] [F] [Am] [C]

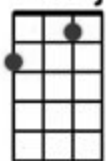
Oh I [G] know I will be loosened from [F] bonds that hold me fast
